CASINO NIGHT GAMING INFORMATION

Each tournament is limited to 50 players.
 Players must begin the tournament with \$1,000 in casino funny money.
 Funny Money can be purchased for \$10 cash per \$100 in Funny Money.




Texas Hold'em
Tournament

Regular poker hand ranks apply. Guests will play a modified progressive Texas Hold 'em Tournament where the blinds will double every round. This is 'no limit' poker, and each player will receive 2 cards down, and then there will be 3 community cards followed by 2 flipped cards. Guests will make their best poker hand from their 2 cards and the 5 community cards. Players will be eliminated from the tournament as they bet and run out of gambling chips, and winners of each round will be consolidated until a final winner is determined.




Black Jack
Tournament

Each player will receive casino chips in 4 different color denominations. As the dealer dispenses cards, guests 'stand' or 'take a hit' to try to reach a total of 21 without going 'bust.' For the first round, the bet minimum will start at \$25. In each consecutive round the bet minimum will rise until players run out of money and are eliminated from the tournament. Players will be consolidated until a final winner is determined.



WAR
Tournament

Guests will choose their opponent and sit at tables with (4) participants per table. Each player starts with 26 cards, and the object of the game is to win all the cards by determining which card is higher in rank. Both players turn their top card face up and put them on the table. Whoever turned the higher card takes both cards and adds them to their pack. Then both players turn up their next card and so on. The game continues until one player has all the cards and wins. The victors will be consolidated and play additional games until an overall War Winner is determined.



CASINO PIT

The Casino pit offers a verity of gambling tables for guests to play including: (1) Craps table, (1) Roulette table, (1) 60' Money wheel and (1) Blackjack table. Guests can purchase gambling chips to use in the Casino Pit. Test your luck at the games to try to accumulate as many chips as possible.
